Your roles and responsibilities:

- Promote the highest possible standards of achievement in MFL for all students (including those for whom we receive a pupil premium, or those that have additional educational needs)
- Ensure that students achieve or exceed their targets in MFL
- Develop a vibrant and exciting MFL curriculum for all learners
- Raise the quality of curriculum and teaching by defining and implementing appropriate improvement targets in MFL and having a clear long term strategy which includes promoting languages at KS4 and KS5
- Lead, manage and develop staff who contribute to the teaching of MFL
- Develop an interest in, and enthusiasm for, languages in all learners including coordinating a range of extracurricular opportunities

As curriculum leader for MFL your department must have:

- Clear, written aims, plans and objectives
- An agreed Raising Achievement Plan
- Agreed schemes of work which include all students
- An agreed SEF evaluating strengths and weaknesses
- High quality assessment and feedback
- Clear, simple records on pupils' progress
- Analysis of standards and how well different groups are doing
- Regular, minuted meetings
- Planned professional development
- Well deployed resources, including support staff
- Plentiful, accessible and high quality resources, often available online
