A'soud Global School (AGS) was established in 2016 in the Seeb area of Muscat, Oman. It has grown quickly and is now home to some 600 pupils across KG1 to Grade 9. We welcome both local Omani and expatriate pupils and our mix of nationalities (over 40), has created a fantastic blend of cultures, experiences and a natural curiosity in our pupils to learn about the world around them. Our teachers are all UK trained and this is seen as a real strength of the school.

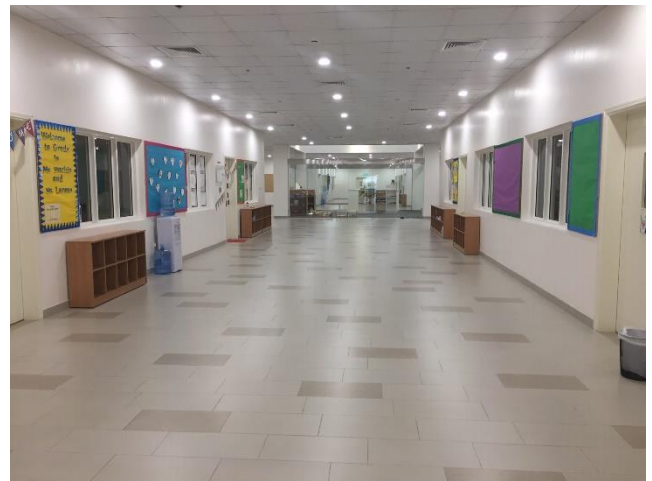
AGS is a co-educational independent all-through school under the management of Al Najah, one of the most successful education groups in the Middle East.

The school boasts excellent and very new facilities. Within our purpose-built site, we have a large multi-court sports hall, drama studios, separate Mac and PC IT suites and specialist science laboratories for physics, chemistry and biology. In addition, we have two swimming pools, tennis and netball courts and an all-weather 3G floodlit football pitch. Within the KG and primary phases, classrooms have excellent inside and outside spaces and the classrooms themselves are large and very well equipped.

Our school is extremely spacious and fully air conditioned and all primary classrooms are equipped with interactive whiteboards. We have a large main school library and also smaller dedicated early Years and Primary library areas as well. We are generously resourced with ready access to the latest UK teaching and learning materials. The school follows a combination of EYFS, IPC and IMYC until Year 9 where we offer a diverse range of IGCSE courses.

We currently have between 2 and 4 classes in each grade from KG1 to Grade 5 and in time we expect to expand to 4 in each grade. At grade 6, all students embark on a secondary curriculum with IGCSEs commencing in Grade 9.

We currently operate a middle management structure with leads across 2 or 3 Grades and the Head of Early Years and Primary will have oversight of the team of teachers working within KG1 to Grade 5.



This is a really exciting time in the life of AGS and this new role offers the suitable candidate the to work with a highly experienced and committed team to establish AGS as one of the premier British Curriculum International Schools in the region.

The position offers an almost unique opportunity to put your own mark on the primary phase of a young and vibrant all-through school.
