Our School opened in September 2014. It is purpose built and very generously resourced with our current enrolment of 2135. We have experienced continuing enrolment growth with outstanding academic results as well as very healthy feedback from the range of inspections we undertake with the local authority, KHDA, with the BSO, with NEASC and when we review ourselves as a Nord Anglia Education School. Across the board we are judged to be 'Very Good' and 'Outstanding' understanding that regular school review is central to school improvement.
