## CREATIVE ARTS AND TECHNOLOGY

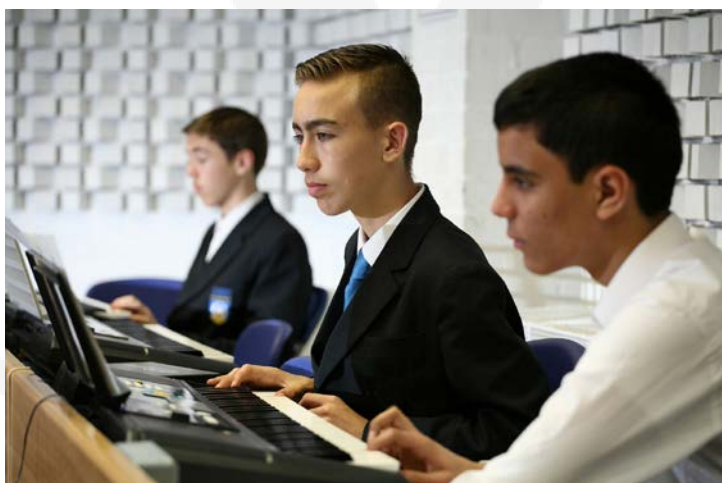
The Quest Academy has a Creative Arts Faculty consisting of five full time specialist members of staff. All staff are keen to share good practice and are supportive of one another. All lessons are delivered by specialist teachers in each of the subject areas covered: Art, Drama, Music and Technology. All teachers are expected to teach across the age and ability range. A Level is offered when there are sufficient numbers.

Currently the subjects taught across KS3 are; Resistant Materials, Graphics, Food Technology, Electronics, Textiles, Art, Drama and Music. In KS4 students are given the opportunity to extend, enhance and showcase their learning by undertaking a GCSE in Product Design, Food Technology, Drama, Music, Art and Design or Textiles.

We have a new fully equipped department that is well resourced and effectively promotes a positive learning environment, where students are engaged and enjoy these very popular subjects.

The department follows the national curriculum at KS3 and at KS4 the department works to AQA and OCR specifications.

The department has a strong focus on enhancing creativity, while still engaging students to learn and use their knowledge of materials, processes and techniques (practical and theoretical) which enables them to become effective, independent learners who strive to complete high quality work that has a creative edge.
