To welcome all participants in a professional and friendly manner Attend regular training and updates. To log and report any incidents/accidents or any other concerns to the Director of Sport. To deliver swimming lessons which are fun and motivate, educate and encourage pupils of varying abilities. To constantly update, manage and complete registers.
