Job Title: Classroom Teacher with Key Stage Responsibility

Job Purpose:

To ensure further raising of Students' attainment in Maths and the quality of teaching in Maths at the allocated Key Stage. The teacher will fulfil the professional responsibilities of a teacher, as set out in the School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document. They will also meet the expectations of a teacher, as set out in the Teachers' Standards. The teacher will also make a positive contribution to the wider life and ethos of the school, continuing the development, implementation and evaluation of the school's policies, practices and procedures, so as to support the school's values and vision.

Key Responsibilities:

- To relentlessly raise standards in KS4 mathematics.
- To ensure provision of an appropriately broad, balanced, relevant and differentiated curriculum for students studying Mathematics in accordance with the aims of the school and the curricular policies determined by the Governing Body and Headteacher.
- To act as a leader for all KS4 pupils.
- To develop and enhance the teaching practice of others.
- To monitor and support the overall progress and development of students as a manager within Mathematics and as a Form tutor.
- To teach Maths across the full range of age and ability, following departmental schemes of work and the National Curriculum;
- To contribute to the development of departmental schemes of work and assessment;
- To set and mark homework according to school and departmental policies;
