#### **JOB PURPOSE**

To deliver Cricket coaching at Rugby School under the guidance of the Director of Cricket and the Director of Sport.

- Assist with the running of the Cricket program at Rugby School under the direction of the Director of Cricket.
- Lead the Girl's Cricket program.
- To coach Cricket to all year groups (boys and girls) and teams throughout the year as directed by the Director of Cricket.
- To set up and manage an MCC Hub Jan March 2023
- To assist with the Sports Scholarship and Aspiring Athlete (AAP) Programme in the School, with focus on the technical and athletic development of Cricket scholars and 'A' team players under the directions of the Head of Strength & Conditioning and Director of Sport.
- To lead the coaching of the indoor Cricket 1-2-1 programme for both the girls and the boys in the Advent and Lent Term
- To support in coaching other sports during games as directed by the Director of Sport during the Advent & Lent Term.
- To maintain and update coaching resources that coaching staff can easily follow to suit pupils of varying age and ability.
- To assist on Sports Scholarship Assessment days, primary / prep school tournaments and Cricket related events run by Rugby School.
- To support the organisation of Pre-Season Cricket and lead the girls' cricket pre season training and overseas tours in conjunction with the Director of Cricket.
- To accompany Cricket Teams to matches in the Trinity term

- To communicate with HMs and Teaching staff when students are away from school for cup fixtures.
- Promote and safeguard the welfare of children and young persons for who the role is responsible and with whom this person comes into contact.
