- Develop an interest in, and passion for Art in all learners including coordinating a range of extracurricular opportunities
- Promote participation in Art including the numbers of students following programmes of study in these areas at both KS4 and KS5

As Curriculum Leader for Art your department must have:

- Clear, written aims, plans and objectives
- An agreed Raising Achievement Plan
- Agreed schemes of work which include all students
- An agreed SEF evaluating strengths and weaknesses
- High quality assessment and feedback
- Clear, simple records on pupils' progress
- Analysis of standards and how well different groups are doing
- Regular, minuted meetings
- Planned professional development
- Well deployed resources, including support staff
- Plentiful, accessible and high quality resources, often available online
