The Teacher of PE reports to the Head of PE (Primary), and would be expected to teach a timetable of up to 48 periods (55 minutes / 10 day cycle). The successful candidate will have the ability to teach Physical Education and Swimming throughout the Primary School at all levels, from EY1 to Year 6, whilst supporting the Senior PE team with Years 7-9. The school's main sports include basketball, football, volleyball, badminton, gymnastics, rugby, softball, golf, tennis and swimming.
