With high standards that demand up-to-date teaching skills and a range of challenging programmes, Beaconhouse School System bring success within the reach of every students.







OUR MISSION AND VISION

INFORMATION ABOUT KUALA LUMPUR

Situated in the midst of the Asia Pacific region, Malaysia enjoys a strategic location and a yearround tropical climate. With 13 states, three Federal Territories and a population that currently stands at more than 32.7 million, Malaysia combines the best of Asia. It is well known for its diverse cultural landscape, which includes three of Asia's oldest civilisations – Malay, Chinese and Indian – and the unique ethnic communities of Sabah and Sarawak.

One of the world's top holiday destinations, Malaysia is filled with a wide variety of unique attractions. Whatever your definition of a fulfilling holiday, Malaysia has all the necessary elements – pristine beaches and breathtaking islands, a rich tapestry of cultures and history, well-preserved heritage treasures, world-class modern facilities, a fascinating collection of flora and fauna, lush and well-maintained nature reserves, a delightful array of mouth-watering cuisine and a long list of shopping hotspots. But do not just take our word for it. Come and discover the many wonders of Malaysia.

Kuala Lumpur, or popularly known as 'KL', is Malaysia's capital city and one of Asia's most dynamic cities. This bustling metropolis is a melting pot of races and cultures, and is home to a population of 3.4 million people. One of the most charming features of this flourishing urban centre is its ability to juxtapose the old and new. Iconic high-rise buildings such as the Petronas Twin Towers and Merdeka 118 stand alongside colonial buildings, creating a delightful contrast. Green-lung areas, upscale shopping malls, themed places of interest and heritage quarters give KL its unique character. Getting around this modern city is convenient with the comprehensive transportation system, along with KL Hop On Hop Off Coach tours, GO KL free bus service and KL City Hall's (DBKL) tram service.

PETRONAS TWIN TOWERS, KLCC

Standing at 451.9 m, the world-renowned Petronas Twin Towers is KLCC's centrepiece and one of the country's most famous icons. The Skybridge on the 41st and 42nd floor doubles up as an excellent viewing platform of the city's skyline. Featuring a futuristic glass-and-steel exterior and a traditionally inspired interior, the 88-storey building reflects Malaysia's aspirations in moving forward while maintaining its national identity and traditional values.

AQUARIA KLCC

Occupying 60,000 sq ft, Aquaria KLCC showcases a variety of marine life from various parts of the world. Visitors can walk through a 90 m long tunnel to view the marine life or watch the daily fish-feeding sessions. Highlights include the 'Cage Rage' and 'Dive with Sharks' programmes that offer a chance to see sharks up close.

KL FOREST ECO-PARK

This sanctuary has the distinction of being the oldest as well as the only permanent forest reserve in the heart of the city. Beginning at the slopes of KL Tower, the lowland dipterocarp forest stretches over 10.5 hectares and is home to a diversity of inhabitants. View the lush foliage from the 70-m boardwalk or join a guided tour to take a closer look at the trees, bamboos, herbs and climbers.

PINTASAN SALOMA (SALOMA BRIDGE)

Saloma Bridge is a 69 m pedestrian bridge that connects the chic KLCC area to Kampung Baru, a heritage zone and popular spot for foodies. All it takes is 15 minutes to get to the other side. This uniquely designed bridge is named in honour of the late Saloma, a singer/actress/fashion icon who was known for her showstopping performances. Its unique design is inspired by Sirih Junjung, a ceremonial betel leaf bouquet used in Malay weddings. Photo buffs will have fun exploring the various angles of this iconic attraction as it is decked with ever-changing LED lights similar to the Bridge of Peace in Tbilisi, Georgia. Get your camera ready for gorgeous OOTD shots! Visitors can access the bridge from the Kampung Baru LRT station or from Public Bank Tower in KLCC.
