MAT/LA level information Guidance

As at November 2019:

School workforce Guidance

As at November 2018, there were:

- 65.3% of teachers with at least one period of sickness absence compared with a national average of 54%.
- 3.9 days on average lost to teacher sickness absence compared with a national average of 4.0.
- no full-time vacant teacher posts in the school.


