Thank you for your interest in the post of Learning Support Assistant (LSA) at Haberdashers' Aske's Hatcham Temple Grove Primary School.

Hatcham Temple Grove provides a safe, rigorous and challenging learning environment for pupils of all abilities and backgrounds. Our expectations are high in terms of pupil progress and achievement, and behaviour.

You will perform a key role in supporting children's learning in all its aspects. You will be required to care and support the learning of individuals or groups of pupils in the primary school under the guidance of the class teacher, SENCO / specialist practitioners, senior leaders, and within the overall ethos of the school. You may be required to teach whole class for some periods as and when required, and support in the setting up of the classroom environment. Experience of working in primary education, including the early year's foundation stage, would be an advantage.

The successful candidate will need to:

- Support the education and social development of pupils under the direction and guidance of the class teacher and SENCO
- Provide support for named pupils to enable them to be fully included and make expected progress
- Establish productive working relationships with pupils, act as a role model and set high expectations
- Promote positive values, attitudes and good pupil behaviour, dealing promptly with conflict and incidents in line with established policy and encourage pupils to take responsibility for their own behaviour
- Support pupils consistently whilst recognising and responding to their individual needs and at the same time promote the inclusion of all pupils
- Employ strategies to recognise and reward achievement of self-reliance, providing feedback to pupils in relation to progress and achievement
- Complete playground duties and assist on educational visits
- Liaise effectively with teachers, other support staff, health and education specialists, parents, visitors and volunteers.
- Work effectively with class teachers on lesson planning, differentiation and setting up the classroom environment
