Gatehouse School is a highly successful and popular London (E2), day, co-ed, prep school (IAPS & ISA); currently with around 420 children aged 3-11. The School is coming to the end of an extensive development project which will see the pupil numbers increase to approximately 520 over the next few years. Founded in 1948 it achieves excellent standards within an inclusive, child-centred and creative environment. It is greatly valued by parents for the quality of teaching, the building of confidence and Christian values, and the quality of pastoral care. Children are encouraged to develop their unique, individual personality and ability within a family-based community where they are encouraged to love learning and appreciate the world.

Gatehouse is located in an attractive, and increasingly popular, area of East London near Victoria Park. The school is housed in an extended Victorian building set in landscaped grounds which includes a spacious outdoor play area and floodlit AstroTurf sports pitch. The school is very well resourced and parents comment that the school buildings and grounds are immaculately maintained.

The school has a very welcoming atmosphere and hums with activity; classrooms are bright, airy and spacious.

Most families live within ten kilometres of the school. The nearest train station is Cambridge Heath. Bethnal Green and Mile End tube stations are a ten to fifteen minute walk away. The school is also served by a number of bus routes. Parking is not available for staff on site but a secure, covered cycle park is available to staff wishing to cycle to work.
