SPECIFIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The postholder must, at all times, carry out his/her duties and responsibilities within the spirit of Forge Valley School Policies, Standing Orders and current legislation with an emphasis on Customer Care, Equal Opportunities, Data Protection and Health and Safety and within the framework of the Education Act 2002, and School Standards and Framework Act 1998 with particular regard to the statutory responsibilities of the Governing Bodies of Schools.

## Leadership and Management

- Contribute to the implementation of whole school policies for quality assurance and performance management

- Take accountability for student attainment and progress within the subject area
- Ensure that robust and rigorous systems for the recording and analysis of progress data are implemented consistently across the subject area
- Track students progress and identify underachievement of groups and individuals promptly
- Implement intervention programmes to address underachievement
- Carry out regular and robust monitoring and evaluation of intervention programmes for individuals and groups of students
- Link with progress leaders to support individuals and groups of students
- Provide reports on performance and progress within the subject area
- Create and implement the Improvement Plan for the subject area reflecting the whole school, curriculum and subject area priorities
- Take responsibility for the effective use of resources within the subject area

## Teaching and Learning

- Act as a role model for quality first teaching for all students
- Ensure that all staff within the subject area are focused on students' learning
- Work collaboratively with other subject leaders and the Director to enhance learning experiences for students
- Work collaboratively with other subject leaders and the Director to ensure high quality provision for students with AEN
- Promote a positive school ethos celebrating individual endeavour and achievement for all
- Ensure the school's rewards policy is implemented consistently across the subject
- Ensure that the school's behaviour policy is implemented consistently and that all staff within the subject area take responsibility for creating and maintaining a positive and purposeful learning environment
- Maintain effective links with pastoral staff to support good behaviour for learning

- Implement the school's philosophy that every teacher is a teacher of students with additional educational needs and has responsibility for the care and guidance of individuals
- Analyse data to ensure that teaching and learning is effective Ensure that students experience meaningful and challenging learning activities in all lessons, including when their teacher is absent
