Faculty

- 110 professional fully qualified faculty members representing 16 nationalities
- Average length of stay is in excess of 6 years
- Low staff turnover (11% in 2017)
- Balanced level of male and female teachers throughout the school

High Performance Sports Academies (Swimming, Football, Golf, Triathlon & Tennis)

- Training is led by professional coaches who have regularly competed at the highest level (including the Olympics).
- Methodologies and training programmes are of the highest standard and follow internationally recognised programmes including RPT (Tennis) and Cruzeiro (Football).
- Competition is at regional and international level with BISP students regularly representing their countries.
- Facilities include golf short course training centre, 50 and 25 metre pools, 6 tennis courts, fully equipped gym and sports hall, 3 full size football pitches (12x7 aside).

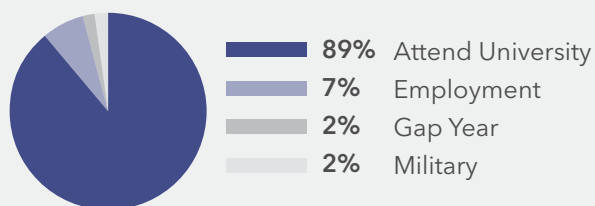

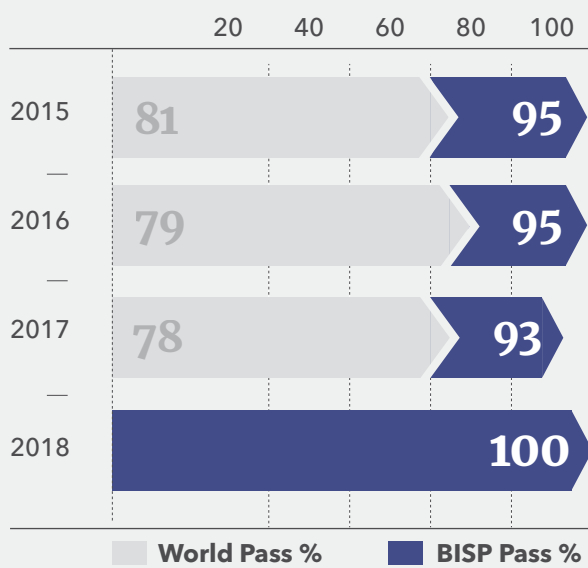
After Graduation Classes of 2015-2018



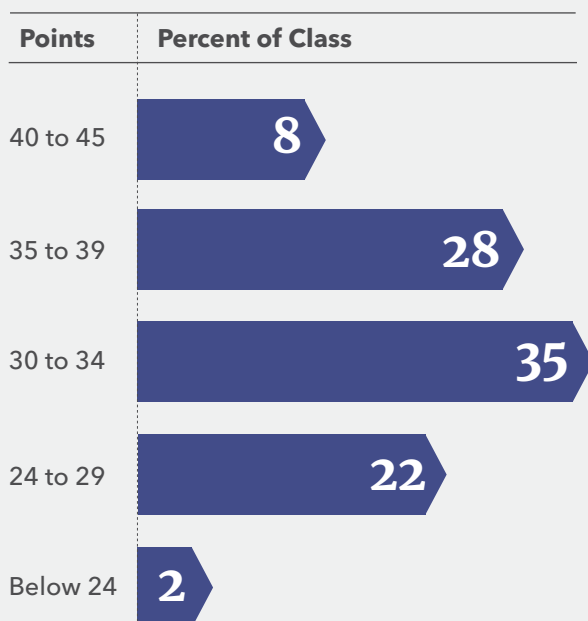
University Applications

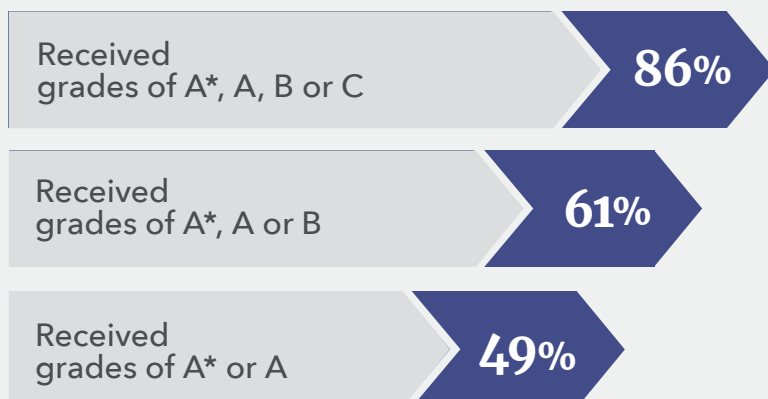

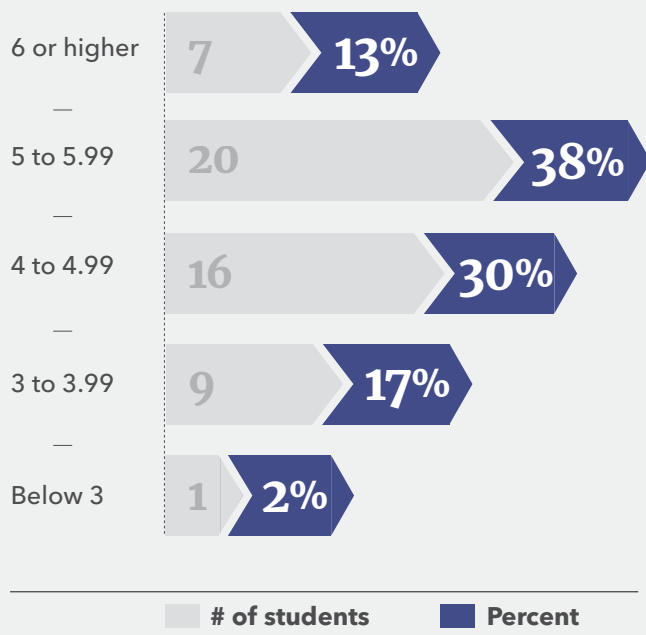
