

St Mary Magdalene C of E School

St Mary Magdalene CofE School is a co-educational, all-through school based in Greenwich, South-East London. We are the only all-through school and only Church of England secondary provision in the Royal Borough of Greenwich.

St Mary Magdalene's secondary phase currently has approximately 720 students aged 11-15 and 80 staff. We are growing year on year and will be full with Years 7 through to 11 by September 2020 and will open our sixth form in September 2021 with capacity for 150 students per year group.

St Mary Magdalene C of E School is part of the wider Koinonia Federation – a Federation of two schools located over three campuses - that work together as one team.

Our Federation includes:

- Christ Church C of E Primary School (1 f.e), East Greenwich
- St Mary Magdalene C of E School with two campuses:
 - Woolwich primary campus-(2 f.e)
 - Peninsula all-through campus which has a primary (2 f.e) and secondary phase (6 f.e)

Our highly skilled and committed staff work collaboratively to deliver quality education for our students. The federation staff are led by both Mrs Claire Harrison and Mrs Victoria Wainwright, the Federation Executive Co-Headteachers. At each campus there are also senior leaders who lead the schools on a day to day basis.

Christ Church is led by the Deputy Head, Sam Reid. Peninsula Primary Phase is led by the Deputy Head, Dayo Ajayi. Peninsula Secondary Phase is led by the Principal, Razwan Hussain. Woolwich Campus is led by Head of School, Tiffany King.

OUR FUTURE SIXTH FORM

Our Post-16 provision is due to open in September 2021 when our own students will transition from Year 11. We also hope to welcome a number of external applicants to our sixth form. We have designed our building to accommodate 300 sixth formers in total with 150 in each year group.

We initially plan to offer 3 pathways:

- A levels
- A combination of A levels and BTEC
- BTECs

Our Head of Sixth form will be instrumental in setting up the Sixth form. During the first year with us, although there will be some teaching allocation (approx.10 hours), for the majority of the working week they will be planning the implementation of our post 16 provision. Once the sixth form commences the post will involve leading and managing the sixth form.
