PHYSICAL EDUCATION AT REDHILL

The Physical Education Faculty is an important part of The Redhill Academy. The faculty receives an excellent level of funding and enjoys good facilities in a "joint-use" relationship with Redhill Leisure Centre. Facilities include a sports hall, gymnasium, a full-sized all weather pitch, athletics areas, four tennis courts, and the use of Arnold Town's football facilities nearby.

Physical Education is taught throughout the school with most students receiving two lessons per week. The programme covers a full range of activities taught to students of all abilities. GCSE Physical Education is a popular and successful option at Key Stage 4, as is AS/A2 PE in Key Stage 5. We also offer Sports Leadership courses, starting in Year 9 with Level 2 and progressing to Level 3 in the Sixth Form.

The PE faculty is comprised of six members of staff. All of which are dedicated and experienced teachers, with an ambitious vision for the future of the faculty.
