

Job Description: Science Technician

Role Specific

- Be able to prepare and maintain resources for the Access to HE science sessions and the BSc (Hons) sports science programmes. This will include the preparation of a variety resources, linked to the curriculum which mainly has a biology/human physiology focus but also includes one unit of chemistry.
- 2. Research, design and trial practicals, as and when required
- 3. Set-up and remove equipment in laboratories, as required
- 4. Clean and maintain equipment and apparatus including Sport Science Lab resources.
- 5. Care for plant and animal collections
- 6. Assist and support practical classes, when required
- 7. Organise and carry out the safe treatment and disposal of materials, including hazardous substances
- 8. Maintain risk register at all times.
- 9. Oversee and manage local stock need.
