JOB DESCRIPTION

Accountability

The Sports Assistant is ultimately accountable to either the Headmaster or Head of Lower School through the Deputy Headmaster, but day-to-day accountability will be to the Head of Department.

Summary of the role:

The Sports Assistant at the Lower School and Upper School will provide in-class support and sports coaching.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assisting with the teaching of pupils during sports and games
- Provide support to the Headmaster, Head of Lower School Sport and Director of Sport as required
- Working collaboratively with PE staff, sports coaches and other staff across the school
- Supporting lessons, including preparation of resources, photocopying.
- Coaching pupils to a good level in one or more sports.
- Administration duties such as filing and organisation of stationary/ textbooks/ office files.
- Undertake such other comparable duties as the Headmaster requires from time to time.
- Attending and supporting with the organisation of weekend fixtures.
