Joining Year 7

If your child has attended one of the local primary schools you will have had some experience of our Primary Transition Programme. We work very closely with the local primary schools to ensure a seamless transition into secondary school.

The rationale for such an extensive programme is as follows:

- We are keen to share our specialist resources and equipment with our primary partners, particularly in areas like science and technology, helping to enhance the learning experience of the children.
- We want to ensure that when students join us in September they are confident, happy and eager to get on with their learning.
- We get to know our new student's academic achievements and can rapidly build on them.
- Every student is allocated a Tutor when they take up a place with us. The Tutor is an important person because they will help ensure new students settle quickly and thrive at their new school. The Tutor is also usually the first point of contact for parents and carers.
