Key Responsibilities: The Teaching Intern reports directly to the designated Head of Departments and is responsible as part of a team for the effective supporting and working with the departments. In particular, the Teaching Intern will;

- work under the direction of the Head of Department, be attached to a particular selection of teaching classes to support the learning of students;
- attend all normal professional development sessions, department development time, department meetings;
- have regular co-planning time with the staff whose classes they are attached to;
- have an agreed mentor and meet regularly with them;
- work with relevant staff to help develop and implement a programme of extension and enrichment activities for more able students in nominated Year groups (including 6th form);
- help deliver academic You-time activities within the department e.g. Science Crest awards, Euclideans;
- be involved with the preparation of Maths/Science students for university applications/interviews etc where appropriate;
- support the preparation and delivery of external competitions within the department e.g. UKMT, FOBISIA Maths etc.;
- work with relevant staff to develop and implement a programme of support for less able students in particular year groups;
- help support and deliver cross-curricular days such as Y8 Maths/Science fun day, Y6/7 Maths and Science transitions;
- requirement to work outside normal hours at the request of the relevant Heads of Department or Year Team Leaders with reasonable notice.
