- Electricity: \$150 – 250
- Water: \$150 - 250
- Natural gas: \$600 (amount varies depending on how much a person cooks)

Overall, fruits and vegetables are sold at economical prices when compared to the UK and the USA. the prices below depend on where items are bought, supermarkets or local shops.

- Beer \$25-35 (depending on the brand)
- Wine \$120 - \$300 depending on brand and likes
- Ham \$200 per kilo (price varies between turkey or pork)
- Bacon \$100 - \$110 (1/4 kilo)
- Chicken \$70 per kilo (whole)
- Chicken breast \$100 per kilo
- Beef \$200 per kilo
- Pork \$180 per kilo
- Apples \$40 per kilo
- Papaya \$30 per kilo
- Banana \$25 per kilo
- Avocados \$60 per kilo
- Carrots \$25 per kilo
- Potatoes \$25 per kilo
- White onions \$30 per kilo
- Green beans \$50 per kilo
- Broccoli \$50 per kilo
