The Role

Our vision for Ark's Teaching School Hub is that it becomes the destination of choice for teacher and leader development across the region and beyond. This key role as the Head of Programmes and Partnerships at the Ark Teaching School Hub, will mean you will be responsible for the operational management of the Teaching School Hub including Early Career Framework, NPQ and other professional development programmes, partnerships with lead providers and other organisations, and the Hub's Appropriate Body services. Working with the Director of Teaching School Hub to ensure that our provision is of the highest quality, you will facilitate professional development that is rooted in evidence-based strategies and enhanced through your understanding of what drives effective school improvement. You will bring in your expertise as an experienced classroom teacher and school leader.

Key Responsibilities

- Operationally manage the Ark Teaching School Hub's (TSH's) professional development programmes.
- Design and facilitate a range of high impact, high quality professional development sessions in response to local and national needs.
- Develop strong partnerships with a range of stakeholders including local schools, Lead Providers and Delivery Partners.
- Leading on external relations and communication activities to promote the launch and ongoing operations of the Teaching School Hub
- Quality assure various programmes and processes across the Teaching School Hub region and wider Ark network

Design and delivery of professional development

- Develop and deliver an Early Career Framework (ECF) Full Induction Programme and range of National Professional Qualifications (NPQs) in partnership with the TSH's Lead Provider.
- Co-ordinate the TSH's other PD programmes including Leverage Leadership and Leadership and Development of Reading programmes.
- Pilot evidence based professional development programmes in Ark schools before wider rollout to the TSH area.
- Pilot evidence based professional development programmes in Ark schools in Birmingham before wider rollout to the TSH area.
- Ensure the TSH's PD programmes operate in a cost effective manner and fall within the financial parameters set by the Director of Teaching School Hub.

Partnership management and network-wide collaboration

• Lead the TSH's work with delivery partners on marketing, onboarding, training, operations, facilitation of PD, and progress tracking of participants within PD programmes.

- Work in collaboration with Ark's Schools Leadership Development Lead on NPQ and other school leadership programmes.
- Work with ATT, Ark's SCITT, to ensure smooth operation of the ATT programme for Birmingham's ATT trainee teachers including PD delivery, targeted support of ATT trainees and quality assurance of coaching and PD.
- Work with ECF leads in schools participating in the TSH's ECF programme.
- Liaise with other Ark teams where there is crossover with TSH work.
- Develop strong relationships with other DfE funded PD providers in the region including Curriculum Hubs, EdTech Demonstrator schools and Research Schools.
- Cordinate and/or fulfil onboarding and other reporting requirements of ECF and NPQ programmes through the TSH's chosen Lead Provider's Management Information System.

Quality assurance and data analysis

- Lead the TSH's Appropriate Body (AB) work ensuring all requirements are fulfilled.
- Generating feedback loops within programmes and from stakeholders to gather data for analysis and evaluation/
- Analyse and evaluate a range of internal and externally sourced data, producing reports/information as required.
- Prepare reports systematically and as and when requested
- Qualify assure the provision of other PD providers as and when requested.
- Maintain accurate records for reporting and auditing purposes.
- Maintain an oversight of participant progression on all PD programmes and developing intervention strategies if and when required.
- Maintain stringent oversight of PD programmes to ensure programmes are on track to meet internal and external KPIs in a cost effective manner.

External relations and communication

- Develop, implement and manage an effective communication strategy for a range of stakeholders and local schools.
- Manage incoming enquiries and make outgoing communication as and when needed
- Lead the operational delivery of internal and external events, both online and face-toface
- In alignment with the TSH's marketing strategy, deliver high quality marketing campaigns to promote the launch and ongoing operations of the Teaching School Hub
- Quality assurance of all outgoing communications

Other
