When considering a career move, one of the major factors is, of course, the surrounding area. We have provided you with a few helpful facts about our location you may want to consider when moving, including housing, childcare, transport and general information about living in North Warwickshire.

Living in North Warwickshire

Atherstone is a pleasant market town and the administrative centre for North Warwickshire. It is situated in a strategically important place in the middle of the country. As such it has become a major hub for key players in the logistics industry with UPS, TNT and Aldi all having major distribution depots in the Borough. Transport links are therefore good with a mainline rail station providing direct trains to Euston in the South and Manchester in the North.

A guide book of Atherstone tells us:

"Atherstone is on the old Roman Watling Street in northern Warwickshire and was famed from Tudor days for making hats. In modern times it is re-inventing itself as a book town and leisure destination, and townsfolk still revel every Shrove Tuesday in a boisterous ball game played since the 13th century. For a flavour of this bustling little market town's heritage head straight for the historic centre and Market Place with its 18th-century buildings, the 16th-century timber-framed Old Swan, an atmospheric coaching inn and the Old Bank House (1711). See, too, Merevale Church on the outskirts, originally the gate chapel to the abbey.

Small, unique bookshops appeal to magpie instincts, there's a monthly farmers' market, and nearby Kingsbury Water Park is great for birdwatching, fishing and cycling. Or visit Bosworth Battlefield Heritage Centre and Country Park which shows Atherstone's links to the final chapter of the Wars of the Roses."

The Roman route Watling Street, linking Anglesey with London, runs right alongside the school.
