Inclusion Team

The Inclusion Team is a friendly and welcoming department and can offer excellent facilities. The Inclusion area offers a pleasant and well-resourced environment. There are 3 teaching classrooms each equipped with an interactive whiteboard and a smaller room available for 1:1 work. ICT equipment is available in all rooms via a wireless network. The department also has a meeting room available.

We are very proud of the attainment of our vulnerable group pupils. RAISE data shows that progress for pupils in these groups is in line with the national average along with progress across the school. Our ethos is to become the leading school based Inclusion Team in West Sussex and we believe we are well on the journey to being so.

We are a very inclusive school. The department aims are to deliver high standards of support to all vulnerable pupils across the school, to track and monitor individual pupil progress and to promote resilience and independence in our boys. Over the last 4 years the department has developed a nurture group for pupils in Y7 and Y8 needing additional support. The group has become so successful that we are now leading on this for secondary schools across West Sussex.

As a department we enjoy working collaboratively and there is ample scope for the person appointed to help build on the successful developments to date. We offer a range of opportunities to get involved with extra-curricular activities including the support of many clubs and trips.
