





Person Specification Executive Headteacher

The successful applicant will be professionally responsible to the Governing Body of the Federation of Carisbrooke College, Medina College and the VI Sixth Form, for the educational success of all learners, at all levels of their study.

The Executive Headteacher (EHT) will be a member of the Governing Body and responsible for internal organisation, and leadership and management across the Federation. He/she will line manage the Heads of School and senior support staff and create a culture of constant improvement, underpinned by consistent fairness, which will challenge and motivate all learners and staff. The successful candidate will need to demonstrate the strengths and skills required in the following areas:

Pupil Progress and Wellbeing

- Securing good learner progress, by ensuring challenging targets are set, so that they meet or exceed their expected levels
- Securing high-level outcomes for all learners at all levels
- Ensuring a safe environment for all learners
- Promotion of excellence in behaviour in the schools and in the community, promoting pride in the schools.
- Integration of high levels of moral, social and cultural development through the provision of support and enrichment opportunities for all learners.

Strategic Leadership

- Strategic planning to secure high academic standards and the financial stability of the Federation
- Capacity to reflect and evaluate, and to use these processes to identify strengths and weaknesses. The EHT
 will build on the strengths and address areas of weakness through supervision of formal improvement
 planning processes.
- Enabling the Federation to respond to the community it serves by working with the Governing Body and the Trust to engage with stakeholders
- Supporting the work of the Trust through partnership and engagement in its activities
- Establishing systems to determine the levels of satisfaction of learners and parents, and address areas of concern with defined action plans that are systematically monitored.
- Promotion of the Federation within the local community
- Planning for the future of the Federation and its schools as local and national circumstances change, including the ambition for the Federation to develop as a centre of excellence on the IoW.
