

In 2024/25, our academic staff synergize in academic and pastoral matters, with educational insights accumulated from our teaching experiences in Brunei, China (Mainland), Honduras, Hong Kong (China), Italy, Japan, Oman, New Zealand, Singapore, South Africa, South Korea, Spain, Thailand, Turkey, United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom, United States and Vietnam. Working at Harrow HHKCS:

- An initial three-year contract.

- Visa, work permit, and residency permit costs paid by the school.








Harrow HKCS offers an education of high standards and outstanding professional opportunities for staff.

- Working knowledge of the relevant subject curriculum issued by the Curriculum Development Council Hong Kong, under the IB Diploma Programme, or the KS1 to KS4 National Curriculum of England.
- Evidence of relevant and challenging continuing professional development.

Knowledge and experience

- Effective implementation of learning and teaching strategies to achieve appropriately set teaching objectives (differentiated if applicable) that are in line with curriculum goals.
- Understanding of how children at the ages for primary or secondary schooling develop and learn.
- Ability to work in a way that promotes the safety and wellbeing of children, in accordance with all relevant safeguarding polices and practice.
- Knowledge and experience of how to use of IT effectively in promoting pupil learning.
- Previous experience or knowledge of working with pupils for whom English is not their first language.
- Effective communication and engagement with parents.
- Previous experience of teaching children is necessary, whether under employment as teacher (preferred)
 or not.

Transport Information to HHKCS	 From Shenzhen Baoan International Airport By Shenzhen Metro: Take Metro Line 11 to Qianhaiwan Station, transfer to Line 5 and get off at Qianwan Park Station. It will take approximately 40 mins in total.
	 From Shenzhen North Station By Shenzhen Metro: Take Metro Line 5 directly to Qianwan Park Station. It will take approximately 60 mins in total.
	 From Shenzhen Bay Port By Shenzhen Metro: Take Metro Line 2 to Haiyue Station, transfer to Line 5 and get off at Qianwan Park Station. It will take approximately 50 mins in total. By Taxi: Approximately 15 minutes.
	• From Luohu Port By Shenzhen Metro: Take Metro Line 1 to Baoan Center Station, transfer to Line 5 and get off at Qianwan Park Station. It will take approximately 70 mins in total.
	 From Futian Port By Shenzhen Metro: Take Metro Line 10 to Gangxia North Station, transfer to Line 11 and get off at Qianhai Bay Station. Then transfer to Line 5 and get off at Qianwan Park Station. It will take approximately 60 mins in total.
