Sociology and Psychology Department

The school is looking to appoint a teacher of Sociology and Psychology to start in April 2021. They should have a particular enthusiasm for Sociology and Psychology and be prepared to teach them to A Level.

Sociology is taught to GCSE where it is a popular option. Students follow the AQA 8192 course which encompasses the units of Family, Education, Social Stratification and Crime/Deviance and Research Methods.

Many of the students' progress to A level where they study the AQA 7192 course. The course builds on the work undertaken at GCSE. The compulsory units are Education with Research Methods and Crime and Deviance. Optional units are chosen from Family, Beliefs in Society and Mass Media. Examinations take place at the end of the second year across three papers.

We offer Psychology at A-Level where students will study the AQA 7182 course with topics including Social Influence, Memory, Attachment, Approaches in Psychology, Psychopathology, Research Methods, and Biopsychology.

The subjects are dynamic and contemporary, with the students being encouraged to take an active part in their learning and to develop an enthusiasm for as well as knowledge of the subject. Conferences, courtroom and museum visits also play a role in the development of the understanding for post-16 students.
