Barham High School is a rural and remote school on the lovely banks of the Murray River. The school has just been awarded an Excellence Awardee for The Australian Educator Best Regional High School.

The school is host to 166 students in 2024 who come from a number of feeder schools both in New South Wales and Victoria who have a diverse range of interests and abilities. The school has a dedicated staff that has a diverse cross—section of beginning and highly experienced teachers. Barham High School has a Muti-Categorical Support Class to assist students in accessing the curriculum and is well resourced with over 350 devices to support student learning, recently refurbished science laboratories and timber/metal workshop The school is a 6 point incentive school which attracts incentives such as the \$20,000 Rural Teacher Incentive, \$10,000 Experienced Teacher Benefit, \$10,000 Stamp Duty Relief and has a 70% teacher housing rental subsidy available. *This position A full list of benefits can be found here: https://benefits.education.nsw.gov.au/ Barham has a number of Teacher Housing options including 1BR and 2BR partially furnished units.
