<b>Key Accountabilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Providing assistance and advice to the Head of Faculty on the design and delivery of the Economics curriculum area so that it meets the aims of the Academy and the needs of all students</li><li>● Ensuring that appropriate approaches to learning are made available to students with specific learning needs.</li><li>● Have a thorough and up-to-date knowledge and understanding of programmes of study and specifications for examination courses</li><li>● Support individual learning by planning work with appropriate challenge and monitoring and reviewing student outcomes regularly</li><li>● Evaluating the design and delivery of the Economics curriculum; continuously striving to improve all aspects</li><li>● Track student progress, monitoring achievement against set targets and take appropriate and early action on student outcomes and under-achievement</li><li>● Assess students' work systematically and use the results to inform future planning, teaching and curricular development</li><li>● Regularly use appropriate ICT initiatives to improve learning for pupils and staff</li><li>● Attend department meetings and contribute to them effectively</li><li>● Providing reports to the Head of Faculty regarding curriculum matters in defined areas</li><li>● Instigating, developing and maintaining links with relevant companies so as to enrich the learning experience of the School Community</li><li>● Be involved in extra-curricular activities such as making a contribution to enrichment activities, trips and visits</li><li>● Be a role model to students through personal presentation and professional conduct</li></ul>
