- Coach and manage your respective teams during all games programmes and events.
- Identify and recommend players for movement to different ability groups.
- Discuss player movements within departmental meetings and inform parents of any movement accordingly.
- Support the recruitment of Academy squads, ensuring recruitment is of the highest standards possible.
- Deliver community initiatives, as required, including PE support, assemblies, after-school clubs, tournaments, events, and school fayres.
- Attend staff meetings and competitions, as required.
- Be active on social media and post regular images to support the promotion of the basketball programme.
- Continually look for ways to develop and improve the coaching programme.
- Undertake Continued Professional Development programmes, organised by the Club.
- Understand, adhere to, and enforce the codes of conduct set by Evolution Sports for players, parents, and coaches.
