- Advise the Matrons and other members of staff on the medical care required for the students and day to day healthcare procedures.
- Actively participate in the promotion of good communications throughout the Community and on occasions accompany staff and students on trips that may require medical support.
- Work within the guidelines of the NMC Code of Professional Conduct.
- Working in conjunction with the local Surgery, assist with GP surgeries and health checks required as part of pupil medical care, using Systm-one as per the data sharing agreement
- Maintain appropriate documentation and report on these as required to the Senior Nursing Officer and Doctor both orally and in writing.
- Stock and equipment: Understand and ensure correct storage and administration of drugs; to assist forward planning of all medical supplies. Monitor use and maintain reasonable levels of supplies
- Health and Safety: Report promptly any accidents, complaints or untoward occurrences
 to the Senior Nursing Officer; be responsible for medical supplies and equipment in
 accordance with Christ's Hospital's Health & Safety Policy and ensure that knowledge of
 H & S as relevant to the department's activities is up to date.
