They will possess the vision to implement pedagogical leadership Federation wide and be willing to go the 'extra mile' to see it implemented successfully.



## **Key Accountabilities**

The Mossbourne Excellent Teacher will provide pedagogical leadership across the Academy and continue to promote, develop and share excellent teaching strategies within the Academy. The Mossbourne Excellent Teacher will be required to support the professional development of staff within the Academy and assist where necessary across the Federation. The Mossbourne Excellent Teacher will offer support and expertise in adapting curriculum to changing specifications and provide a consistent model of outstanding teaching practice. The key accountabilities of the role will include:

- To work in collaboration with the Senior Leadership and other Mossbourne Excellent Teachers to build on the existing best practices to develop a Federation wide system for teaching, learning, and training
- To support the Senior Leadership in developing a range of activities and strategies to strengthen teaching and learning
- To promote the use of all key teaching and learning strategies
- To contribute to the planning, development, delivery and leadership of all training and INSET
- To use mentoring and coaching strategies to support individual staff to become outstanding practitioners: from 'good' to 'outstanding' and from 'Requires Improvement' to 'Good'
- To participate in the training, monitoring and mentoring of NQTs and Schools Direct training teachers
- To engage in professional dialogue with specific colleagues to ensure continued improvement in teaching and offer advice and support in respect to learning and pedagogy
- To develop a climate for learning and classroom ethos that supports a pedagogy of providing challenge in teaching settings as a basis for improving mainstream practice
- To embody the Academy ethos and take part in marketing and liaison activities
- To observe colleagues on at least weekly basis and give objective feedback, setting targets for improvement where appropriate and following up with praise or strategies for improvement where appropriate
- To plan and deliver high-quality, differentiated lessons on a daily basis and ensure they are consistently rated outstanding
- To work with Subject Leads and SLT, to ensure effective provision of teaching and learning across the Academy
- To keep abreast of developments in education and ensure that new developments and changes in course content are introduced and delivered
- To support and promote the ethos of the Academy, playing a full role in daily life of the Academy as expected of general teaching staff
- To set homework in accordance with policy and to mark work regularly to aid progression, keeping clear records of attainment and following up on non-submission
