### Brass Teacher Outline:

To support the work of the music department at Mount St Mary's College and Barlborough Hall School by teaching one to one lessons on a range of brass instruments and coaching and conducting ensembles as required. The brass teacher is an experienced musician who will work with the music department to ensure a forward thinking and ambitious musical team.

### Key Competencies:

- Dynamic approach to supporting pupils
- Instruction on technique, music literacy and all aspects of performance
- Drive for improvement
- Creativity
- Soft skills - communication

### Key Responsibilities / Accountabilities:

- To teach the brass instruments to pupils aged 5-18 across two different sites in one-to-one lessons.
- To work alongside the other visiting music staff in planning timetables.
- To contribute to ensembles and orchestras by mutual agreement with the Director of Music.
- To work as part of a team in planning repertoire for concerts and offering performing opportunities for pupils.
- To contribute to departmental discussions regarding repertoire and events.
- To assist the work of both music departments by dealing with administrative and other matters. This includes overseeing instrumental stock, liaising with the finance office, updating attendance registers and monitoring the music library.
- To assist in the scholarship audition process and prepare suitable candidates for auditions.
- To liaise with the Director of Music about all matters.

### Attitudes and Qualities:

- Committed individual with an interest in Jesuit education
- Enthusiasm for working with pupils and an ability to relate and inspire them
- Positive and flexible approach to working with others
- Ability to take initiative
- Strong sense of responsibility

### Skills and Knowledge:

- Exceptional level of performance on one or more brass instruments
- Ability to lead ensembles
- Understanding of safeguarding within a school setting
- Strong organisational skills
- Excellent communication skills
- IT literacy
- Rapport building skills
