The British School Al Khubairat (BSAK) is Abu Dhabi's leading British not-for-profit, co-educational, day school. It is also the only British Embassy School in the UAE.

The School was founded in 1968 and generously supported by the late President of the UAE, His Highness Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, through the donation of land and Amiri Decree No. 5 of 1971. The School is under the ongoing patronage of the British Ambassador and is sponsored by His Highness Sheikh Khalifa Bin Zayed Al Nahyan, the current President of the United Arab Emirates.

We are immensely proud of these historic links, and today our long-standing reputation and heritage continue to shape our ethos as we celebrate over 50 years of exceeding expectations.

At the heart of our constitution is our status as a not-for-profit and academically non-selective community school. From Nursery to Sixth Form, our aim is to deliver excellence in teaching for learning, bringing everything that is outstanding about the British curriculum to the United Arab Emirates, and we are a member of IAPS, ISBA, HMC and BSME.

The values of Empathy and Care, Respect and Inclusivity, Honesty and Integrity, Endeavour and Resilience have underpinned the School's educational philosophy from the beginning. There is a culture of giving and service at the core of our purpose, decisions and actions. We foster a welcoming environment for our BSAK families, which is genuinely friendly and happy. The School engenders an inclusive community spirit, in which everyone is valued, reinforcing cultural diversity, equality and empathy. We are a caring school with the safety and wellbeing of our students always at the forefront.

We are rated Outstanding across all performance standards in both our local Government Agency inspection (ADEK) and that of British Schools Overseas (BSO); in 2019 we were awarded Best British School in the UAE and Best Post-16 Education in the Schools Compared, Top School Awards. We are also the first school outside of the UK to receive the Carnegie Gold Award for Mental Health and we have gained the Green Flag Award for our environmental drive.

BSAK provides a full and broad education fit for the modern world, and our mission is to nurture a genuine passion for learning, through world-class teachers, trusted leadership and dedicated support staff.

We inspire and challenge our students, of all academic abilities, to become well-rounded individuals ready to progress to the next stage of their education and life beyond BSAK and Abu Dhabi. Through dedicated support for each individual student, we invest in building future leaders.


BSAK Secondary School is thriving. We currently have 916 students on roll, with almost 250 students in our award winning Sixth Form. We have outstanding facilities, wonderful teachers, and we teach amazing students; BSAK is a happy, vibrant and exciting place to work!

BSAK follows the National Curriculum of England, while intertwining the MOE curriculum throughout Key Stage 3. We have developed a broad and balanced curriculum, which challenges students to ready themselves for their GCSE years. Key Stage 4 offers a combination of GCSE and iGCSEs, with 25 subject choices.

The BSAK Sixth Form was named the 'Best Post 16 Provision in the UAE' at the Schools Compared 'Top Schools' Awards in 2019. It is the largest Sixth Form in the Emirate, and offers a huge amount of opportunities, including 23 A Level choices and 6 BTEC programmes. It also provides opportunities for holistic growth, with the in-house Future Leaders Diploma, accompanied by the EPQ and ILM Level 2 Young Leaders Award, which offer outstanding personalised academic and leadership enrichment. Our student destinations are over 70% UK universities - many to prestigious destinations such as Oxbridge, UCL and Imperial, with over 70% achieving their first choice. The remaining leavers go onto prestigious universities from across the globe, including the US (including Brown and Stanford), Canada and Australasia.

We consider ourselves a Teaching *for* Learning school, where staff development is driven through evidence informed and research engaged practice. We have staff who are at the forefront of their practice, several of whom have been published in particular fields of education. BSAK staff are constantly challenged, and challenge themselves, to further develop themselves as practitioners who are rightly considered world class.

BSAK has been a Google School for over 3 years. The Google Apps for education are used as the vehicle for online learning, with every student in Years 7 - 11 having their own school provided Chromebook, with the Sixth Form having a BYOD policy. As an ACER Innovative School winner, we are proud of the journey we have been on with this aspect of learning, which has stood the school in good stead for the Covid-19 period.

Our Co-Curricular provision is a real strength of BSAK. Through our Academic Enrichment, Performing Arts, and the Sports programmes, students excel in their strengths, and also push the boundaries of what they believe they are capable of to reach tremendous heights. Examples of this are Model United Nations (MUN), Public Speaking competitions, Global Social Leaders, School Newspaper (BSAK Tribune), Art Exhibitions, Young Musician of the Gulf winners, incredible annual school performances, (with 'We Will Rock You' in 2019, and a host of regionally renowned sporting achievements including becoming World School Games winners in 2019 and BSME U19 Games Champions in 2020).

BSAK is a warm, vibrant and exciting environment to work in. Leadership development is actively encouraged and self-reflection is expected.

SCIENCE DEPARTMENT

AT BSAK

The Science Department at BSAK is flourishing. All three sciences are popular at A Level and we are proud of our public examination results. Each year, a good number of students go on to further education in science related fields. At KS3, science is taught as a combined subject with a curriculum designed to lay strong foundations in content and skills ready for GCSE study. Students are taught by subject specialists from Year 10. Depending on the cohort, between half and two-thirds of students at GCSE take the three AQA separate sciences with the remainder taking the Combined Science (Trilogy) course. Edexcel specifications are followed at A Level.

Currently, the department has four physics teachers, five chemistry teachers and five biology teachers, as well as a part time science teacher. We are supported by a fantastic team of technicians which enables us to deliver high quality practical work.

Science is a well-resourced department, and we are looking forward to moving into a new purpose built science centre in the next academic year.

Science offers a variety of co-curricular activities including MedSoc, Science Club and Olympiads. With an increase in teaching allocation we are seeking a well-qualified full-time science teacher to join the department. The successful candidate must be able to teach KS3 science and KS4 in any of the three subjects. A Level teaching will be available for suitably qualified candidates.
