Responsibilities:

The Sport Intern reports directly to the Director of Sports and Activities and is responsible as part of a team for the effective coaching and teaching of sports and activities. In particular, the Sports Intern will;

- lead Strength & Conditioning delivery across the school;
- assist sports coaches and teaching staff in sport and athletic development principles and practices;
- lead in the management of a Shrewsbury sports team;
- lead (under the guidance of the Director of Sport and Activities) in the delivery of the marketing of sport at Shrewsbury through social media;
- work with marketing department (under the guidance of the Director of Sport and Activities) to ensure high quality communication through SOCS software and other methods;
- assist in the operation of all house sporting competitions;
- act as a lifeguard;
- assist in tournament organisation;
- assist the Director of Sport and Activities in the development and delivery of Team Shrewsbury;
- assist the Director of Sport and Activities in the delivery of You-Time, Additional Activities and liaison with external sport coaches;
- deliver sports analysis and coding under the direction of the Director of Sport and Activities;
- carry out appropriate sports monitoring and physical profiling of athletes to inform training prescription, set physical targets and provide information and feedback to pupils and coaches;
- special projects as directed by the Director of Sport and Activities;
- requirement to work outside normal hours at the request of the Director of Sport and Activities with reasonable notice.
