



JOB OVERVIEW

We are excited to offer a rewarding opportunity for a dedicated and experienced Learning Support Assistant (LSA) to join our team supporting a pupil in KS1.

As an LSA at Maple Walk, you will play a pivotal role in supporting the children's learning and development. The role will include 1:1 support for a specific student and responsibility for planning, preparing and delivering an adapted curriculum working with that child and other pupils in small groups. The role may also involve accompanying the pupil to sports lessons and trips over the course of the year.

Key to the success of the role will be the ability to collaborate with the class teacher and external professionals to incorporate their recommendations into curriculum planning. Planning time will be allocated within the school timetable.
