Coombe Girls' School and Sixth Form

Coombe Girls' School and Sixth Form is a comprehensive girls' state secondary school, with a co-educational Sixth Form. The school is heavily oversubscribed and is committed to providing an excellent education to children in the local area. We are proud of the progress our students make from their starting points during their time with us: the school's Progress 8 score is provisionally +0.65 and over 40% of GCSE entries were graded 7 to 9 last year. The school is proud to be part of the Coombe Academy Trust.

Our school is vibrant and diverse, serving the local area of New Malden. We value every individual and the rich wealth of experience, knowledge, values and beliefs they bring to our school. The experience and talent you will bring to our school will ensure we continue to provide the best education for our students and further increase the breadth of opportunity for the next generation. We particularly encourage applications from colleagues in underrepresented groups.

















The Science Department

The department consists of an enthusiastic team of 16 teachers working in ten well-resourced laboratories. Our Science team encompasses a range of ages and experience and are a happy, collegiate group. A number of staff hold responsibility posts in Science including Heads of each of the three Sciences, a Second in Science. The department has forged positive, mutually beneficial links with colleagues in the Science department at Coombe Boys' School. The department is well equipped in terms of apparatus and textbooks and enjoys the support of technicians. The Science department has extensive data logging apparatus, access to computer suites and makes extensive use of Google Classroom as well as Google sites.

At Key Stage 3 the curriculum is delivered using bespoke material based on the National Curriculum and is designed to excite and engage as well as prepare pupils for AQA Science GCSEs. Year 11, 10 and 9 Science is delivered by separate teachers for each of the three Sciences; Biology, Chemistry and Physics. In Year 7, 8 and 9 pupils are taught in mixed prior attainment groups. At Key Stage 4, 70% of pupils follow the AQA Trilogy Double Science course with the other 30% taking separate GCSEs in Biology, Chemistry and Physics. Those students on separate sciences receive 14 hours of teaching a fortnight; those on Combined Science 9 hours a fortnight. The combined Science award course is delivered by subject specialists where possible. The Separate Science courses are always delivered by subject specialists.

The following courses are taught at A level:

- OCR Biology A
- OCR Chemistry
- OCR Physics A

Extra curricular activities include:

- GCSE, AS and A2 intervention sessions
- Science Club for KS3
- Year 7 annual Science Fair in the summer term
- STEM club for KS4 and 5
- Year 8 Science museum
- External speakers
- Science challenge events for KS4
- CERN trip for KS5 Physicists

Main Responsibilities

- Routine maintenance of Key stage 3-5 equipment
- Preparation of lesson orders for Key stage 3-5 across all sciences
- Support in preparation of lesson orders and routine maintenance of Key Stage 3-5 science equipment where need arises (e.g. in staff absence or other special circumstances)
- · Getting apparatus ready and setting up in the right place at the right time
- · Checking adequate safety precautions are being met
- Assisting with safety checks of laboratories
- Cleaning up after lessons and keeping laboratories and prep rooms tidy
- Keeping check of stock and re-ordering as required
- Placing authorised orders on the computer and checking orders received
- In conjunction with the other technicians, set up and maintain a computerised stock recording system for the department
- Support the provision of teaching resources to lessons where needed (e.g. textbooks)
- Other responsibilities according to circumstances as directed by the Head of Science or Headteacher
