- To teach English/Science/Maths/Vocational subject at KS3 and 4 levels effectively and creatively across the age and ability range, working 1 to 1 with students or in small groups, in the Achievement Support area, or at the student's home
- To ensure pupils are assessed as per department and School policy and use the assessments to motivate pupils and set targets to enhance student learning
- To report to Inclusion team the pupil progress so that work can be built upon in subsequent lessons.
- To follow department policies regarding schemes of work
- Expected qualification (Degree or an expertise in Maths, English, Science or Vocational Subject)
