Position Summary: We are seeking an inspirational practitioner to teach English Language and Literature to native and non-native learners by bringing creativity, flexibility, passion and a love of English to an already thriving academic department. The candidate will report principally to the Head of English. The candidate is expected to teach a timetable of up to 48 periods (55 minutes / 10 day cycle). The English department comprises highly motivated and experienced staff teaching throughout the Senior School (Years 7 - 13) and academic expectations are high across all Key Stages. The majority of students take English as a First Language IGCSE and English Literature IGCSE, with English Literature AS and A Level being offered in the Sixth Form. Interest is high in the subject whose numbers at A Level have grown in both Years 12 and 13 with outstanding outcomes for students.

Candidate Profile: The successful candidate:

- will be a well-qualified English specialist;
- will be a dedicated, highly motivated teacher capable of inspiring students;
- will have a full working knowledge and direct experience of teaching the English National Curriculum and an ability and aspiration to attain the highest standards;
- will preferably have experience of teaching the Cambridge iGCSE English Language syllabus, although this is not a requirement;
- will preferably have experience of teaching multilingual learners or a desire to broaden his/her experience and skills in this area;
- will have a flexible approach to working within the school curriculum and structures;
- will have demonstrated a commitment to high-quality extracurricular and cocurricular activities to support students to achieve their potential inside and outside of the classroom;
