The Biology Department is housed in its own building with five laboratories, a prep room (with separate technician), a library for pupils and a staff office. The Department is well-equipped and resourced. Each laboratory has been refurbished to a high standard, and has a computer with projector.

Biology is taught as a separate science from Year 7. At Key Stage 4 all pupils study three separate Sciences and follow the Edexcel International GCSE course.



Biology proves popular at A-level with up to five sets in a year group. The course currently followed is the Edexcel Biology B Specification.

- Promote positive attitudes in the classroom, encouraging respect, tolerance, co-operation, courtesy and self-control at all times;
- Record and report the details of each child's progress, achievement and effort;
- Support pupils and colleagues fully in organisation of a diverse range of tasks, from examination preparation and marking to participating in/organising co-curricular activities;
- Maintain regular effective communication with colleagues and attend weekly Departmental meetings;
- Review their own effectiveness in their respective role;
- Develop their own range of skills and knowledge;
- Maintain standards and implement the Department's and the School's policies and procedures;
- Play a part in the School's diverse range of co-curricular activities programme.
