The Sports Department

Sport is an integral part of both the school's curricular and co-curricular offering. The school vision is to continue to develop a school sporting programme that harbours a passion and enjoyment of participation in sport, and playing as part of a team, that will be carried forward beyond school life.

All students undertake a weekly afternoon games session, as well as an additional 1 hour 20 minutes of curriculum PE at KS3. These sessions are then supplemented with clubs and training sessions which take place before and after school, and a full programme of competitive opportunities on a Saturday. These fixtures are played against other schools in netball, rugby, cricket, lacrosse, swimming, athletics, tennis, volleyball and football. This programme of is staffed by a combination of graduates and specialist coaches.

The school was independently selected as one of the UK's top 100 senior cricket schools, recognised for its outstanding indoor county level cricket nets, specialist coaching and programme of fixtures. The school has formed partnerships with Dorking Wanderers FC, Old Reigatians RFC, London Pulse Netball and Surrey Country cricket. The school has three netball courts, a 25m swimming pool and has recently installed a gym for use by pupils and staff.



The Role

It is an exciting time for sport in Dunottar as the school continues to grow and we are looking to appoint an inspiring Director of Sport to lead this successful department into the next phase of its development. This is an outstanding opportunity to build on the excellent work of the current post holder and to develop further the school's distinctive sporting culture. The school strongly believes that mass participation and high standards can, and should, coexist and they expect the successful candidate to have the drive, determination and well-developed interpersonal skills to ensure that is the case.

The Director of Sport reports directly to the Deputy Head Operations and will be responsible for the vision, strategic direction and management of sport. They will be committed to providing highquality sporting opportunities and experiences for all students and for ensuring that each and every pupil develops physical literacy and a strong exercise habit. The successful candidate will be an inspiring leader and will create a nurturing and motivating environment for pupils and members of the PE department.





GCSE and A level Physical Education are popular subjects beyond Year 9 and take up of GCSE is strong and increasing every year, with some continuing to A level, whilst others participate in the accredited Sports Leaders Programme. The Director of Sport would need to provide dynamic leadership and support to the Head of Academic Physical Education to ensure excellent academic results are achieved whilst maintaining the high profile of curriculum Physical Education at the school. They will also develop and enhance performance pathways for our sports scholars and ensure that our Warrior Learner behaviours of aspiration, creativity, curiosity, tenacity, independence, collaboration and inclusivity are thoroughly embedded in all aspects of sport.

To enhance pupils' experience of the subject we also organise a number of sports tours which the successful candidate would be expected to participate in or lead. The successful candidate will be expected to make a contribution to these initiatives as well as to the co-curricular programme.

Our Location and Facilities

Dunottar School is based in a handsome Palladian-style mansion set in 15 acres of beautiful grounds, just outside Reigate town centre. In addition to the main Mansion House, the school has modern wings housing classrooms, a university-style Sixth Form Centre with rec room and café, a recently opened £4.5m Performing Arts Centre, with music practice rooms and a 500-seat theatre, art and DT studios, a 25m indoor swimming pool, a large Sports Hall with 4-lane cricket net system and three floodlit, our brand new Courtyard Gym with cardio equipment and free weights and outdoor netball courts. Lacrosse, rugby and football fixtures are played at Old Reigatians RFC, where we have use of three grass lacrosse pitches, as well as extensive and well-maintained rugby and football pitches.
