Al Basma is a popular, high performing ENC School in Al Bahia, Abu Dhabi. Al Bahia is a quiet and safe neighbourhood of Abu Dhabi near to the international airport and Yas Island. Dubai is a 35 minute drive from the school. Attracting students from all over Abu Dhabi we are a truly international school community. Our well-behaved students and supportive parents originate from 50 countries and speak 28 languages.

Al Basma opened in 2014 with the current senior leadership team and Principal joining in 2015. Our teaching staff are all UK trained and are almost all from the UK.

Our seven form entry school caters for 1400 children from FS1 to Y13 with 450 students enrolled in Y7 to 13 in 20/21. We opened a state of the art Primary block for Y3 to Y6 in September 2020. The expansion enables us to accommodate an additional 1000 students over the next five years. As a result the secondary section will continue to expand year on year until the 7 form entry currently in Y5 reaches Y13.

Al Basma aspires to create a global community of critical thinkers, creators, innovators and leaders who will have a positive impact on the world of tomorrow. We pride ourselves on being a happy and vibrant community where students, parents and teachers enjoy coming to school.





As an all through school serving children from age 3 to 18 we follow the 2014 National Curriculum of England and the EYFS Statutory Framework. We use GL CAT4 and Progress tests from Y4 to Y10. In addition we offer GCSE, iGCSE, iAS and iA Levels from Cambridge and Edexcel exam boards covering a wide range of arts, technology and humanities subjects as well as the core subjects. In addition we offer the statutory MOE curriculum in Arabic and UAE Social Studies for all students and Islamic for Muslim students. We will be expanding our offer to include BTEC qualifications for Year 12 and 13 from September 2021 in line with the new MOE high school graduation requirements.

The campus is well resourced and boasts excellent facilities. Situated on the first and second floor of our original building, the Secondary section houses 35 classrooms as well as a suite of specialist rooms including 5 Science labs, 2 Art studios, 2 Computer suites, DT, Robotics and CAD CAM Labs, Music and Drama studios and an Innovation and AI Lab. In addition, our Y12 and 13 students have dedicated study and breakout areas to use during their non contact study periods.







There are currently 47 ENC teachers within the secondary school team. In addition there are 10 Ministry of Education teachers delivering the Arabic, Islamic and Social Studies curriculum.

The secondary VP is supported by 2 Senior Teachers responsible for pastoral leadership in KS3, 4 and 5 as well as 8 Curriculum

Leaders and 6 Year Leaders.

#### Al Basma British School Inspection Information

The school gained BSO (British Schools Overseas) accreditation in May 2016 following a successful inspection in its second year of operation. In January 2017 in its third year of operation it had its second ADEK inspection and was placed in Band A - 'a high performing' school. Moving from satisfactory in 2015 to good in 2017, it was graded very good with outstanding features in its third ADEK inspection in January 2019.

Most recently in February 2019 the second BSO inspection graded the school good with many outstanding features, with the inspectors commenting on the school's remarkable rate of improvement.

# The Role of Vice Principal

The successful candidate will have overall responsibility for the day to day running and pastoral leadership of Y7 to 13. In addition, they will be assigned a whole school responsibility which will be decided upon appointment based on their personal strengths and experience.

The successful candidate will be expected to play a central role in leading the performance management and ongoing professional development of their team including overseeing the progress of NQTs, ECTs and AO candidates in their team through UK accredited induction programmes.

The successful candidate will be responsible for ensuring that planning, intervention, personalised pathways and the curriculum implemented in Y7 to 13 is data driven. They will also be responsible for assessment recording and reporting within the secondary section.

The successful candidate will show a genuine commitment to creating an inspiring and stimulating child-centred learning environment. Candidates should be committed to ongoing school improvement and feel comfortable in a climate of innovative and creative development.


