Whilst this is in the making I thought I would give you an idea of what you can expect if you join our team. We are a relatively new Senior Leadership Team and since joining John Betts have worked towards building a really supportive staff body. One way in which we have done this is to deliver a two year rolling curriculum. This means that despite being a one form entry school you have a planning partner and someone who you are able to bounce ideas off. Our SLT are also very hands on and will support your practice through team teaching, planning and modelling.

CPD is extremely important for all staff at whatever stage of their career. Despite budget cuts we ensure that we enable all to access training that is going to support your personal goals and develop you as a professional. Training is provided by the Local Authority, independent bodies such as Osris and where suitable we work with other local schools. NQT's are provided with a high level of support and offered a years' worth of training. Middle and Senior Leadership training is also encouraged and provided where applicable.

Teaching and working in schools is undoubtedly high pressure and we are acutely aware of this. To ease this we have put a number of measures in place to alleviate this. We ensure that your PPA is blocked so that you are able to be as productive as possible. We provide breakfast on a Friday morning to have a catch up and off load the issues of the week. We arrange special events throughout the academic calendar to add some variety to the curriculum; this does mean there is a risk you may have to dress up...
