Job role and notes

Pay and hours:

The role will be full-time. The salary will be paid at Point 7 on the pay scale (from 01.04.19 this will be £19,554pa pro-rata). Normal arrangements will be for 38 term weeks per year plus holidays and the need to be available, if required, for INSET days or other special days.

Role:

Covering lessons for absent teaching staff – this will require using work set by teachers, issuing, supporting, supervising collecting in of the work and any related activities to ensure the smooth running of the lesson.

It is likely that there will be duties such as break-time supervision that will be agreed at the time of the appointment or thereafter.

It is likely that the person appointed will need to undergo First Aid training.

The role is an excellent opportunity for colleagues interested in a career in teaching to gain a huge amount of experience within a school and the education system. We would be willing to support any CPD relevant to the role. We would be pleased to support, for example, lesson observations and other training that would support progression onto PGCE, GTP or qualified teacher posts.

Sports Coaching

Job role

The role will involve coaching during games lessons and practices with fixtures after school and some on Saturdays. It will require the candidate to select teams and communicate effectively with students, staff and parents. The role of a Sports Coach requires a commitment and an enthusiasm that goes beyond the limits of any formal agreement.

The role will require the person appointed to take full responsibility for the training, management and development of an identified team (s). There will, of course, be significant support from the other staff.

Some additional training may need to be undertaken to develop or update qualifications. We would usually fund training but sometimes the training may take place in the employee's own time, by agreement.

A high standard of netball or rugby coaching is essential and the ability to teach/coach other sports would be desirable.
