Key Responsibilities and Tasks

- To work collaboratively with colleagues to plan and teach Mathematics lessons that are effective, creative, varied and appropriate to the needs of the students
- To effectively utilise Google Classroom and other technology when teaching to ensure that learning is current, relevant and enjoyable
