Creative Arts is comprised of Art, Music and Drama. We are a team of 10: 9 specialist teaching staff, (3 Art, 4 Drama, 2 Music) and 1 Creative Arts technician. The Creative Arts Faculty are passionate about their specialisms and dedicated to providing exceptional learning experiences both in and out of the classroom.

At KS3 all 3 subjects are largely practical and taught over 2 periods, each, a fortnight. Uptake at KS4 is very high compared to the national average in all 3 subject areas. BTEC is offered alongside the traditional GCSE Music course. Results at GCSE are high in all subjects, particularly Music.

The Faculty has a wide range of accommodation for teaching ranging from recently refurbished Music rooms (including Mac suite), purpose built Drama Block, to specialist Art rooms including a Kiln room.

The Faculty provides an extensive range of creative extra-curricular opportunities for students with numerous Art, Drama and Music clubs alongside the whole Faculty annual project of the school Musical show. All 3 subject areas organise residential trips and/or cultural outings. Activities this year include Pop Choir, Show Band, Art Club, Marple Hall Theatre Company and The Shakespeare School's project for PP students.
