

Bank View is a special school for students with complex learning difficulties. We are a successful school looking to appoint dynamic English Teachers who are outstanding practitioners.

Bank View is based over 3 sites in Fazakerley, Croxteth and Speke. The English teacher roles are based at our Fazakerley and Speke site, however there may be a requirement to work across any of the 3 sites. The Fazakerley site has a purpose-built building for SEN students. We have 350 students on roll, all have an EHC plan.

In 2019 OFSTED rated us outstanding in all areas. 'This is a happy school. There is genuine warmth between the pupils and staff. Relationships are strong, and staff know each pupil exceptionally well.'

We require imaginative, energetic and highly motivated teachers, with the skills and knowledge to teach pupils with complex learning difficulties at secondary level. You will be responsible for the development and delivery of the English curriculum. You will teach students with a wide range of ability (from entry level 1 to GCSE) and special educational needs.

Bank View is part of the HEARTS project which seeks to achieve better outcomes for our students and their families and enhance the lives of communities across Liverpool. As a school we are passionate about working with other professionals to address the critical issues of attachment and trauma for the benefit of our whole learning community.

Experience of working within a SEN setting is desirable but not essential.
