The British International School Budapest seeks enthusiastic, flexible, committed teachers to join our school from August 2026. We are a close-knit, supportive team of professionals, dedicated to the education, well-being, and growth of our international community of students.



Our students, aged 3-18, comprise over 70 nationalities and enjoy a British-style international education through the medium of English. Starting in a spacious Early Years Centre, the National Curriculum for England frames the education provision through to the end of Key Stage 4, when students take GCSEs and IGCSEs before embarking on the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme in our Sixth Form. We are ambitious for our students, who progress to top universities around the world.

OUR LOCATION AND OUR FACILITIES

Located beside a golf course in the leafy 3rd District of Budapest, a short distance from the Danube and the city centre, our school campus is modern and well-resourced. Primary students benefit from one-to-one iPads and secondary students bring their own laptops. Specialist rooms are equipped with first class facilities, enabling our students to take advantage of our collaborations with MIT, The Juilliard School, UNICEF, and IMG Academy. Three major development projects in three years have added additional facilities for science, computing, visual art, the performing arts, and sports.

Our Global Campus, in addition to the extensive online connections, allows students access to our mountain adventure camp in the Swiss Alps, our safari and community service camp in Tanzania, our partners at MIT, The Juilliard School, UNICEF at the UN Headquarters in New York, and IMG Academy for sport.

Budapest is a modern, cosmopolitan city, steeped in history and within easy reach of beautiful countryside. Condé Nast Traveller regularly places Budapest as one of the best cities in the world to visit. Budapest is also one of the world's most affordable cities, located in the heart of Europe, within easy reach of the best of central, eastern, and western Europe. Public transport, the arts and culture, shopping, dining, and outdoor activity are incomparable. Several of our teachers have chosen to settle here, while others move on to international careers within Nord Anglia Education and beyond.
