TEACHER OF MODERN LANGUAGES – FRENCH / SPANISH

TEACHING WEEK

Broadwater has a 25 hour teaching week, operating 50 x 60 minute lessons, 5 lessons a day, 3 in the morning and 2 in the afternoon over 10 days.

MODERN LANGUAGES CURRICULUM

In year 7 students study 3 lessons of French and 3 lessons of Spanish per fortnight. They study either Spanish or French in year 8, 6 lessons per fortnight.

At KS4, Years 9, 10 and 11 students are able to study a full language course. They are allocated 5 x 60 minute lessons a fortnight.

Accommodation and Equipment

Modern Languages are located in well-equipped and recently refurbished rooms, on the second floor. Each teacher has their own teaching room. An interactive whiteboard and computer are available in each classroom. The department has access to ICT suites in the school and wireless netbooks.

MANAGEMENT

There are 2 full time members of the Department including the Head of Department. Regular meetings are held to plan courses and evaluate progress. We are also looking for an innovative Head of Modern Languages to develop the courses with the use of ICT and improve links abroad.

RESOURCES

There is a good provision of interactive text books. Years 7 and 8 French use Dynamo and Studio 2, Year 7 and 8 Spanish use Vivo 1 and 2. The courses are complemented by a wide range of additional resources.

GCSE Syllabus

Students currently take French & Spanish GCSE's with AQA.

TRIPS

A willingness to organise and participate in exchanges or trips and extra-curricular activities would be expected.
